HOW IT WORKS

- **To be eligible as a Mentee**, you must be enrolled as a first-year law student and in good standing at an ABA-approved law school.

- **LCLD will match you** with one of our volunteer Mentors based on a range of possible factors (e.g., practice area, location, etc.).
- LCLD will reach out to connect you with your Mentor.
